Fiesta Challenge Regulations

*All cars must comply with Technical Regulations for **Autotest Vehicles***

Engine.

Capacity is limited to naturally aspirated 1400cc Petrol / LPG, naturally aspirated 1700cc Diesel & 1400cc Turbo Diesel..

Nitrous Oxide injection is not permitted. Standard engine block for that model of car must be used, maximum re-bore +0.060". Standard inlet and exhaust manifold and fuel delivery system must be used.

Transmission.

No four-wheel-drive system is permitted. The manufacturer's original gearbox and axle with all internals as originally supplied for that model of car must be retained and in their original position. No torque biasing, locked differentials or traction control devices are permitted.

Suspension and Steering.

Suspension operation must be as manufacturer's specification.

Brakes – Unrestricted.

Electrical / Interior.

Interior trim and lights may be removed but standard dashboards must be retained. Additional instruments may be added. Functioning alternator and starter motor must be retained. All seats apart from the driver's & front passenger's may be removed, and the specification of the driver's seat may be changed.

Bodywork.

The complete body shell, doors, boot, & tailgate must be in production material, with no modification or lightening.

Windscreens must be of laminated glass.

For Autocross / Clubcross mud Flaps are required on all 4 wheels and vehicles must comply with the Motorsport UK *Yearbook (BlueBook) Section (N)4 – Class A cars.*

Wheels and Tyres.

Wheel sizes and material must be as manufacturer's specification. No wheel spacers are permitted.

Safety.

Vehicles need not be taxed nor MOT tested. A roll-over bar or roll-cage may be fitted. Cars must be of presentable appearance.

Championship points.

The car must be entered in the appropriate capacity class on the event and the SDMC Competition Secretary should be notified prior to the event or immediately after it of the car's eligibility for the Fiesta class.
