

# Stonehaven & District Motor Club

## Club Championship Regulations



### Eligibility

1. The Championship is open to all fully paid up members of Stonehaven & District Motor Club (SDMC) Limited.
2. Points will **NOT** be counted for any individual prior to the date that they made full payment of their SDMC membership for the current calendar year.
3. Club members who wish to win any of the Club, Ladies & Seniors Championships **MUST** officiate (ie must be signed on as an event official or marshal) on at least 1 event that is organised by SDMC (excluding social events) or at which SDMC have been asked to marshal a stage or section of an event (eg. Snowman Rally or Granite City Rally etc) during the current calendar year.
4. The Junior Championship is open to all SDMC members aged 21 years or under at 30<sup>th</sup> November of the current calendar year.
5. The Senior Championship is open to all SDMC members aged 50 years or over after 30<sup>th</sup> November in the previous calendar year.
6. The Marshal's Championship is open to all individuals who marshal on SDMC events or events at which SDMC have been requested to marshal a stage or section irrespective of whether they are club members.

### Entries for Events

Event regulations and entry forms will be available on the SDMC website ([www.sdmc.org.uk](http://www.sdmc.org.uk)) as early as possible prior to each event.

### Number of Events to Count

The number of events that count towards the eligible competitors final score is detailed alongside each championship. If all of the events do not run, the table below defines the number of events to count.

For example, if 7 events run in a championship, only the top 5 scores of an eligible competitor who has competed in these events will count (example above). If any event is moved to a date less than one week prior to the SDMC Annual Awards Dinner then that event will not count towards any of the Championships. If more than 18 events count one extra score will count for each two events added.

### Points System

A straight 10, 9, 8,.... points system will be used with overall placings taken for rallies (ie Experts then Non-Experts then Novices). In all other categories points will be awarded based on class positions.

Event organisers (Clerk of Course and Secretary) will score 10 points once only for organising an event.

Club members who marshal on SDMC run events will score three points.

If the event is organised by SDMC competitors must enter under SDMC to score points. For non-SDMC events points will be awarded irrespective of club entered under. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that they are entered under the correct club on the entry list.

### Best Performance Only to Count

Where a competitor enters more than once in any event, then only his / her best performance in that event shall count for points. His / Her other entries shall still be included in the results and calculation of other competitors' points.

## Ties in Events

In the event of a tie for a place on an event, each competitor shall receive the points for that place. Event tie-breakers will not be used

## Ties in Championship

In the event of a tie in any section for an award, the award shall be given to the competitor gaining the greater number of first placings, taking account SDMC members only. Should this not resolve the tie then the number of second and subsequent placings shall be considered. If this fails to resolve the tie then the performance in other events in the section shall be considered, ie the championship counters not included in the competitor's total. (dropped scores)

Any disputes will be resolved at the committee's discretion.

**Rally Championships** - (maximum 6 event scores from 9 count - Consists of Expert, Non-Expert, and Novice classes, stage events will be awarded Expert class points or points for appropriate navigational grade)

Events 1, 3, 4, 5, 8, 13, 16, 18 and 19 count in the Rally Championships.

**Autotest Championship** - (maximum 3 event scores from 5 count)

Events 2, 6, 9, 11 and 20 count in the Autotest Championship.

**Speed Championship** - (maximum 3 event scores from 5 count)

Events 10, 12 and 15 count in the Speed Championship. (Additional autocross events may be run by ADMC, dates to be confirmed. These may be added to the championship if confirmed prior to first round (6<sup>th</sup> June) and adequate notice can be given to all members.)

**Fiesta Trophy** - (maximum 7 event scores from 10 count)

Events 2, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12, 14, 17 and 20 count towards the Fiesta Trophy

**Junior Championship** - (maximum 6 event scores from 9 count)

Events 4, 6, 10, 11, 12, 14, 15, 17, and 18 count in the Junior Championship

**Marshal's Championship** - (all scores count)

Events 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 17, 18 and 19 count in the Marshal's Championship.
