Club Championship Regulations

1.0 Eligibility

- 1.The Championship is open to all fully paid up members of Stonehaven & District Motor Club (SDMC) Limited.
- 2.Points will **NOT** be awarded to any individual prior to the date that they made full payment of their SDMC membership for the current calendar year.
- 3.Club members who wish to win any of the Club Championships; Overall, Ladies, Senior, Junior, Rally, Autotest, Speed or Fiesta, **MUST** officiate (ie must be signed on as an event official or marshal) on at least 1 event organised by SDMC or on an event at which SDMC have been asked to marshal (eg. HCC Snowman Rally or ADMC Granite City Rally etc) during the current calendar year.
- 4.The Junior Championship is open to all SDMC members aged 21 years or under at 30th November of the current calendar year.
- 5.The Senior Championship is open to all SDMC members aged 50 years or over at 30th November in the previous calendar year.
- 6.The Marshal's Championship is open to all individuals who marshal on SDMC events or events at which SDMC have been requested to marshal irrespective of whether they are club members.

2.0 Entries for Events

Event regulations and entry forms will be available on the SDMC website (www.sdmc.co.uk) as early as possible prior to each event.

3.0 Number of Events to Count

The number of events that count towards the eligible competitor's final score is detailed alongside each championship. If all of the events do not run, the table below defines the number of events to count.

For example, if **7** events run in a championship, only the top **5** scores of an eligible competitor who has competed in these events will count (example above). If any event is moved to a date less than one week prior to the SDMC Annual Awards Dinner then that event will not count towards any of the Championships. If more than 20 events count one extra score will count for each two events added.

4.0 Points System

A straight 10, 9, 8,.... points system will be used with overall placings taken for rallies (ie Experts then Non-Experts then Novices). In all other categories points will be awarded based on class positions. Event organisers (Clerk of Course and Secretary) will score 10 points once only for organising an event. Individuals who marshal on eligible events will score three points. If the event is organised by SDMC, competitors must enter under SDMC to score points. For non-SDMC events points will be awarded irrespective of club entered under. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that they are entered under the correct club on the entry list.

5.0 Best Performance only to count

Where a competitor enters more than once in any event, then only their best performance in that event shall count for points. Their other entries shall still be included in the results and calculation of other competitors' points.

6.0 Ties in Events

In the event of a tie for a place on an event, each competitor shall receive the points for that place. Event tie-breakers will not be used

7.0 Ties in Championship

In the event of a tie in any section for an award, the award shall be given to the competitor gaining the greater number of first placings, taking account SDMC members only. Should this not resolve the tie then the number of second and subsequent placings shall be considered. If this fails to resolve the tie then the performance in other events in the section shall be considered, i.e. the championship counters not included in the competitor's total dropped scores.

Any disputes will be resolved at the committee's discretion.

- 1. Club Championship** - (maximum 12 event scores from 20 to count). All events to count.
- 2. Ladies Championship** - (maximum 12 event scores from 20 to count). All events to count.
- 3. Rally Championship** - (maximum 6 event scores from 9 to count) - Consists of Expert, Non-Expert, and Novice classes; Stage & Classic events will be awarded appropriate navigational class points.
Events 1, 3, 4, 6, 7, 10, 14, 17 and 19 count in the Rally Championships.
- 4. Autotest Championship** - (maximum 3 event scores from 5 to count)
Events 5, 8, 12, 13 and 20 count in the Autotest Championship.
- 5. Speed Championship** - (maximum 2 event scores from 3 to count)
Events 11, 15 and 16 count in the Speed Championship. (Additional autocross events may be run by ADCM, dates to be confirmed. These may be added to the championship if confirmed prior to first round and adequate notice can be given to all members.)
- 6. Fiesta Trophy** - (maximum 7 event scores from 11 to count)
Events 2, 5, 8, 9, 11, 12, 13, 15, 16, 18 and 20 count towards the Fiesta Trophy
- 7. Junior Championship** – is awarded to the highest placed Junior in the Club Championship at year-end.
- 8. Senior Championship** – is awarded to the highest placed Senior in the Club Championship at year-end.
- 9. Marshal's Championship** - (all scores count)
Events 2, 3, 4, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13, 14, 15, 16, 18 and 19 count in the Marshal's Championship.
