



Supplementary Regulations

Clubcross, 3rd August 2008 Nether Auquhollie, Stonehaven

1. The Stonehaven & District Motor Club Ltd will promote a National B status Autocross on 3rd August 2008 at Nether Auquhollie, near Stonehaven.
2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association, (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may use for the event.
3. MSA Permit no is **TBA**.
4. The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club and also members of clubs which are affiliated to the East of Scotland Association of Car Clubs and the Association of West of Scotland Car Clubs.
5. All drivers must produce a valid Club Membership Card and a Competition Licence of Clubman or higher grade at signing on. **Licence applications can be accepted on the day of the event. Competitors must provide a valid Clubman Licence. Failure to do so will incur the non-production of licence fine of £47.00 (no exceptions!)**
6. The event is a round of the SDMC Club Championship, the SDMC Fiesta Championship, the SDMC Junior Championship, and the SDMC Speed Championship.
7. The program of the event will be:-

Paddock opens at 09:00

Scrutineering and signing on starts at 09:30

Practice starts at 10:30

Any competitor not signed on and completed walking the course by 11:00 may be excluded

First timed run starts 11:30

8. The length of the course is 1600 metres approx., which consists of 2 laps of a 800 metre track with nine corners.
9. The event will consist of four classes as follows: -

Class A Economy "Standard" Production Saloon Cars up to 2000cc as per E.106

Class B Road Saloon Cars up to 2000cc as per E.106

Class C Minicross Cars as per E.106

Class D Stock Hatch Rallycross Cars as per E.106

NOTE: The only tyre eligible shall be of Highway pattern (i.e. not of an off road or on/off road or winter pattern as per E.107)

10. Classes may be amalgamated if less than 4 entries are received in a class.
11. Limited slip differentials are not permitted.
12. Awards (dependent upon amalgamation of classes) will be presented as follows:-

1st overall (FTD) A perpetual award

1st in class A perpetual award

The awards will be presented at the annual dinner in November.

13. The entry list opens on receipt of these regs and closes at 22.00 hrs on Friday 6th June 2008. The entry fee for the Clubman event is £35.00. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. Cheques to be made payable to "Stonehaven & District Motor Club". Entries not paid for by the above date will incur a 50% increase as per the SDMC Club Championship regulations (no exception will be made).

15. The maximum entry for the meeting is 60 and the minimum is 15. The maximum for each class is 20 and the minimum is 4. Should any of the above minimum figures be reached the organisers have the right to amalgamate classes or cancel the meeting. Entry will be selected by receipt. Entry fees may be refunded if cancelled 24 hours prior to the meeting.

17. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after each run, or following the end of the event.

18. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with [C(d)] 45-59

19. Starting order will be in class order. Timing will be by stopwatch. The starting signal will be a green light. The finish line will be indicated by a chequered flag.

20. Competitors will have the opportunity of one practice run of two laps. A second practice may be available depending on the condition of the field.

21. Competitors will be identified by numbers competition numbers of MSA specified size and type on **both** sides of the vehicle. Numbers will be available provided at signing on.

22. Marking and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the MSA General regulations, except the following which is modified:-

E.65 Touching a penalty marker 5 seconds per marker

All four wheels off – No Time recorded and in addition the car must stop and not proceed until instructed to do so by an official.

E.61 There will be four timed runs of two laps each, of which the fastest two runs will count for results.

23. All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written. Except as modified below:-

E.82 Classes are as stated in 9 above.

24. Anyone practising or travelling at excessive speed out with the specified course, will be automatically excluded.

25. Marking and penalties will be printed in the MSA General Regulations except as modified:

26. All other General Regulations apply. E.59 will apply, i.e. a car may be driven by up to four drivers.

27. Entries will be accepted from competitors aged 14 or over. Refer to MSA General Regulations E.47 – E.50 for compliance details.
