Supplementary Regulations



1. **Stonehaven & District Motor Club Ltd.** will promote a Clubman status AutoSolo, Autotest and a Production Car Autotest on Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> March 2019 at Grampian Transport Museum, Alford AB33 8AE. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK incorporating the provisions of the International Code of the FIA, these supplementary regulations, and any written instructions the promoting club may issue.
  
2. **Championships:** The event is a round of the Scottish Road Car Series Championship [SRCS] (registration required), the Scottish Street Car Showdown Championship [SSCS] (registration required) and the SDMC Club Championships (SDMC members only)
  
3. **Permits:** Motorsport UK Permit Nos.

4. **Invited Clubs:** The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising Club and also members of the following invited Clubs:

5. **Club Cards:** All entrants must produce a valid club membership card, (if necessary, can be purchased at signing on)
  
6. **Age of Drivers:** Entries for the Autosolo and PCA may be accepted from Drivers who are aged 14 years and over who do not have a valid, full RTA Licence (M16 & M21) subject to:
  - a) The vehicle must by definition be a 'Touring Car'
  - b) The vehicle engine capacity must not exceed 2000cc forced induction
  - c) A passenger must be carried who holds a valid, full RTA licence, and be experienced in Autotests or AutoSolos.

Entries to autotest will be accepted from drivers aged 16 years and over (M13). All vehicles driven by these drivers must comply with the following specifications:

  - d) The vehicle must by definition be a 'Touring Car';
  - e) Engine capacity must not exceed 1400cc;
  - f) Forced induction is not permitted.

7. **Programme:** The meeting will be:- Scrutineering starts at 09.30a.m., and any competitor not signed on by 10.45.a.m. may be excluded. First car starts at 11.00.a.m.
  
8. **Classes:** The event will consist of the following Classes, with no differentiation for engine capacity or car size:-
  - Class 1. AutoSOLO (Road Cars that are Taxed & MOT'd)
  - Class 2. Autotest (all Untaxed Cars and Specials)
  - Class 3A. Production Car Autotest
  - Class 3B. Junior Production Car Autotest

For entries in Class 1 AutoSOLO the driver may elect to carry one passenger (M21). Entries in Classes 3A and 3B Production Car Autotest must carry one passenger (M16), unless registered in the SCS. No other passengers are allowed. In all cases the same passenger must be carried throughout the event, must occupy the seat alongside the driver and must wear a properly fastened and approved seat belt at all times during tests.

Entries in Class 1 AutoSOLO and Class 3A PCA will be accepted from drivers aged 14 years and over (M17, M22). Entries in Class 3B will be accepted from drivers aged 14 years minimum but under 18 years. Entries in Class 2 Autotest will be accepted from drivers aged 16 years and over (M13). All vehicles driven by these drivers must comply with the specifications set out in Motorsport UK General Regulations (M13, 17, 22).

9. **Technical:** Details of technical regulations for autosolos, autotests and PCA's are available in the 2019 Yearbook on the Motorsport UK website.

All vehicles must comply with Motorsport UK Technical Regulations (J, M4, M19, M24). The following General Regulations are Modified - M 5.1 Vehicles need not be registered or taxed. M 5.3 Light Goods and standard production Hybrid, Electric, and Battery-Powered vehicles are permitted in appropriate classes.

The passenger in a Touring Car, or a Cabriolet/Sports Car with the hood erected or a hardtop fitted, must be aged 12 years or over and be at least 135cm in height. The passenger in a Cabriolet/Sports Car without the hood erected or hardtop fitted must be aged 16 years or over and be at least 135cm in height.

10. **Safeguarding:-** If competitor is under 18, Entry Form must be countersigned by a parent or guardian. The Parent or guardian, or an appointed representative must be present during the competition and must sign on the competitors signing on sheet. If a parent or guardian will not be present, a responsible adult representative must be appointed, must show written authority from the parent or guardian to act as the child's representative and must countersign the competitors signing on sheet

11. **Awards:** will be presented as follows in each event:-

FTD- an award.

1st in class- an award providing 3 or more start in the class.

12. **Entries:** The entry list opens on receipt of these regulations and closes finally at 19.00 on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> March 2019. No Entries will be accepted on the day of the event. The entry fee is £20.00. Entries can be made by emailing the completed & signed entry form, identifying your payment method. Alternatively the completed & signed form can be mailed along with a cheque.

Confirmation of receipt of entries will be dispatched by e-mail as soon as possible.

Acceptance of entries will be at the discretion of the Organisers, and entries may be refused without any reason being given.

15. **Protests:** Any protest must be lodged as per C5

16. **Tests:** (a) Details of the tests will be available at signing on. (b) Each driver will have 3 runs at each test with the best 2 result to count. (c) Timing will be by hand held watch. (d) The starting signal will be 3,2,1,GO. (e) The order of attempting tests will be in class order. Practising will not be allowed.

17. **Numbers:** Competitors will be identified by numbers, which will be provided by the organisers.
18. **Marking and penalties:** will be as printed in the appropriate section of the Motorsport UK General Regulations. All other General Regulations of the Motorsport UK apply as written except for the following, which are modified:- M.6.6. Pylons may be less than 1 metre high.
19. **Camping:** Camping for tents or caravans is available at the nearby Haughton House Holiday Park, Alford, which is less than 5 min drive from the event venue. Full details and costs are available through following link.
