JUNE AUTOTEST 16th June 2019 Supplementary Regulations

1. The Stonehaven & District Motor Club Limited will organise a **Clubman Autotest** and **Clubman Production Car Autotest** on Sunday 16th June 2019 at Coneyhatch Farm, Stonehaven. OS Map Reference 45 / 870894. The event will be promoted by the North East of Scotland Motorsports Club and will take place on a sealed surface.
2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations, and any written instruction the organising club may issue.
3. Motorsport UK Permit Nos: Clubman Autotest; 113496
Clubman Production Car Autotest; 113497
4. The event is open to all fully paid up members of the organising club and any club which is a member of the Scottish Association of Motorsport Clubs.
5. Entrants must produce a valid club membership card of one of the invited clubs.
6. The event is a round of the following championships;
Stonehaven & DMC Club Championships 2019.
North East of Scotland Motorsports Club Championships 2019
SAMSC Scottish Autotest Championship 2019 (Motorsport UK Championship Registration number is 76/2019).

7. The programme of the meeting shall be:-

Paddock Opens	10.00hrs
Scrutineering	10.30hrs
First Car Starts	11.00hrs

NB: Any competitor not signed in by 1100hrs may be excluded.

8. The Clubman Autotest will consist of 4 classes as follows:-

Class 1	Specials & Kit Cars
Class 2	All other vehicles up to 1400cc
Class 3	All other vehicles 1401 and over
Class 4	Cars to SDMC "Fiesta Class" regulations
Class 5	Hybrid or Electric Powered Cars – <u>Must be Standard Production Cars</u>

The Clubman Production Car Autotest will consist of 1 class as follows:-

Class 6	Production cars all capacities (as per M19)

In the Production Car Autotest a passenger must be carried at all times.(M16) Passengers must be a member of one of the invited clubs and must be signed on. Passengers do not need to be included on the entry form and can be changed during the day. The passenger must be aged 12 years or over at least 135cm in height and wear a seat belt. Where the driver does not hold a full RTA licence the passenger must hold one and be experienced in Autotests or Autosolos.

Competitors in a cabriolet or sports car may compete without the hood erected or hardtop fitted, but please note M16.5 regarding passengers.

Entries will be accepted from drivers aged 14 years or over in accordance with M17.

Where the competitor is under 18 the entry form must be countersigned by a parent or guardian. The parent or guardian or an appointed representative must be present during the competition and must sign on the competitors' signing on sheet. If a parent or guardian will not be present, a responsible adult must be appointed, and must show written authority from the parent or guardian to act as the child's representative on a Motorsport UK Parental Consent Form and must countersign the competitors' signing on sheet.

9. All vehicles must comply with RAC MSA Technical Regulations.
10. The event will take place wholly on private property and vehicles do not require to be road taxed.
11. Vehicles may be entered by up to 3 different drivers.
12. Awards will be presented as follows: Fastest time of the day in each event- perpetual award.
13. Individual class awards may be presented depending on number of competitors. Awards will be presented at the annual SDMC Dinner & Awards in November.
14. The entry list opens on receipt of these regulations and closes at 2200hrs on Thursday 13th June 2019. The entry fee is £10.00. **All entries should be made and paid online through our partner "Entry Central"** (more info on sdmc.co.uk/events) or if unable to do so, fill in an official entry form and send payment via PayPal or Cheque. Cheques should be made payable to Stonehaven & District Motor Club.

The maximum entry for the meeting is 30 and the minimum is 12. The minimum for each class is 4. Should either of the above minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary.

Entry fees will be refunded if event is cancelled. There may be a small refund penalty for payments received via PayPal.

18. Any protests must be lodged as per C5.
19. Details of the tests will be available at signing on.
20. Each driver will have two runs at each test with the best result to count.
21. Timing will be by hand held watch.
22. The starting signal will be 3, 2, 1, Go.
23. The order of attempting tests will be in class order.
24. Practising will not be allowed.
25. Competitors will be identified by numbers which will be provided by the organisers.
26. Marking and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the RAC MSA General Regulations.
27. Course markers may be less than 1m in height.
28. Anyone practising or travelling at excessive speed out with the specified course will be automatically excluded.
29. **Access to the venue is by permission of the landowner, please obey the speed limit signs and be considerate to other users of the farm buildings. We depend on this venue, please do not give the landowner any reason to withdraw his permission.**
