



# Production Car Trial Supplementary Regulations 30<sup>th</sup> August 2023

Stonehaven and District Motor Club Ltd. Promotes a production car trial at a venue near Hospital Shields Farm. Garvock OS Reference 45/726677, GPS coordinates 56.798717, -2.455189. The venue is a grass field.

1. The meeting will be governed by the general regulations of Motorsport UK, incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA, these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue.
2. MSUK Permit number 132526
3. The event is open to all members of SDMC.
  - All competitors must have a valid membership card.
  - All competitors must hold, at a minimum, a valid RS Clubman licence.
4. Meeting Program:
  - Paddock opens at 16:00hrs 30<sup>th</sup> August 2023
  - There will be minimal scrutineering at the event.
  - Competitors will be required to complete signing-on and self declaration that their vehicle meets the relevant regulations prior to the event.
  - First runs expected no later than 17:45hrs.
5. Classes are as follows:
  - Class A : Front wheel drive saloon cars.
  - Class B : Rear wheel drive saloon cars.
  - Class C : Rear wheel drive sports cars.
  - Class D : Pre 1950 cars.
  - Class E : All trails specials, cars with LSD / Torque biasing, kit cars, compliant cars with MSUK Classic trails classes 4, 6, 7 and 8.
6. All vehicles must comply with MSUK technical regulations except:
  - Regulations 9.8.1 and 9.8.2 do not apply.
  - Passengers do not need to be carried.
  - The number and position of passengers cannot be altered during the event.
  - If a passenger or passengers are carried the front seat must always be occupied.
  - The front passenger seat must be located in the position when the vehicle was first produced.
  - **Permanent and selectable 4 wheel drive vehicles are not allowed.**

7. Tyres:

- **M&S, Off – Road, ATV, Agricultural, hand – cut tyres are not allowed.**
- **Tyres that have had their type markings removed or obscured are not allowed. As per regulations 10.9.4, 11.12.6b, 11.12.6c and 11.12.6d**
- Class A – D minimum pressure 15psi
- Class A – D with traction control, minimum pressure 18psi
- Class A – D tyres with 3 peaks mountain snowflake symbol, as per regulation 11.12.6a (waived for this “winter tyre” only) minimum pressure 22psi.
- Class E minimum pressure 18psi

8. Marshals present will be considered to be judges of fact to adjudicate on items listed under GR M. 3. 5.1.

9. The entry list opens on the publication of these regulations and closes on Monday 28<sup>th</sup> August 2023. Late entries or entries on the day will be considered.

10. Entries:

- The entry fee is £15:00p per competitor.
- All entries must be made on the attached entry form.
- Payment via Bank transfer SDMC sort code 80 – 09 – 68, account number 00826299 Please use reference with PCT (Your name)
- Payment in cash can be made on the day. No other form of payment will be accepted.
- The minimum number of entries is 5 the maximum 30
- The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event if sufficient entries are not received by the closing date.
- Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event.
- Any protests must be lodged in accordance with MSUK regulations O.5.1.

11. Other Regulations:

- As the event is held on private ground competing vehicles do not need to be registered, taxed, or MoT'd
- All vehicles **must** be properly silenced.
- Practising or travelling at excessive speed outwith the specified courses, within the paddock area or on the adjacent public road will result in **exclusion**.
- Competitors and crews found to be blocking the adjacent public road will result in **exclusion**.

12. Recommendations

- Vehicles should be fitted with a front towing eye for recovery purposes.
- Competitors should bring tape to attach supplied competition numbers.
- Pens / pencils to complete score sheets, documentation etc.

This is a new venue for Stonehaven and District Motor Club. The organisers hope that all competitors and crews will recognise that the venue is in a very quiet rural setting with “sensitive” neighbours. The landowner and or representative is likely to attend to observe.
