



TOUR OF GRAMPIAN REGULATIONS

1. Announcement:

Stonehaven & District Motor Club will organise a **Touring Assembly** (the Tour of Grampian) to be held on **Saturday 4th May 2024**.

The event will start and finish at **Milton of Crathes Events Field, Banchory, AB31 5QH** with a lunch halt at Peel Farm, Lintrathen, Kirriemuir, Angus DD8 5JJ

The route will be approximately 150 miles.

2. Jurisdiction:

The event will be held under the general rules of Motorsport UK as a Touring Assembly and these Supplementary Regulations and any other written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event. A Motorsport UK Touring Assembly Permit has been granted under number: **136105**

3. Eligibility:

The event is open to all members and non-members of Stonehaven & District Motor Club.

4. Vehicles:

Vehicles must have a valid MOT certificate and be road taxed (if applicable) and comply with Motorsport UK regulations for the event. All tyres must be road legal. Participants are responsible for ensuring that all drivers of the vehicles entered are fully insured for the duration of the event as required by the Road Traffic Acts. All crew members will also be required to Sign On at the start of the event for insurance purposes.

5. Entry List:

Entries open on publication of these regulations and entry form. Entries close at noon on Sunday 21st April 2024. Refunds for withdrawn entries will be at the discretion of the organisers.

6. Documentation:

Event documentation will be handed out at the start venue between 08:30 and 09:15. Final instructions will be emailed to entrants during the week before the event.

7. Route, Navigation and Driving Behaviour:

The first car will depart at 09:30.

The route will be approximately 150 miles on public A and B class roads and unclassified roads. The route will be on sealed surfaces. Be aware that some sections of the roads may be uneven and care should be exercised on vehicles with low ground clearance.

The route will be defined by a tulip road book which will be supplied at the start venue.

Navigation will be in the form of "tulip" (ball and arrow) diagrams and a marked map. No other large scale maps are required.

Participants must at all times comply with the requirements of the Road Traffic Acts and drive in a responsible and considerate manner. Failure to do so may result, after an official warning, in exclusion from the event.

8. Entries:

The entry fee is £30.00 for a crew of two. This includes a self-adhesive rally plate with car number to be displayed on the front or bonnet of the car, a road book and marked map. The entry fee does not include the cost of meals, refreshments or accommodation. A range of food from Peel Farm Coffee Shop will be available for purchase at the lunch halt. <https://www.peelfarm.com>

To register, please complete the entry form. Entries will be confirmed by email after the closing date on Sunday 21st April 2024, **please do not make payment until your entry has been confirmed.**

Payment will only be accepted by electronic bank transfer. **Verbal entries will not be accepted.**

Maximum number of entries is 50, the minimum number of entries is 20.
