

June Autotest 11th June 2023 Supplementary Regulations

- The Stonehaven & District Motor Club Limited will organise a Clubman Autotest and Clubman Production Car Autotest on Sunday 11th June 2023 at New Mains of Ury Farm, Stonehaven AB39 3QA. The event will be promoted by the North East of Scotland Motorsports Club and will take place on a sealed surface.
- The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations, and any written instruction the organising club may issue.

3. Motorsport UK Permit No's: Clubman Autotest: 131736

Clubman Production Car Autotest: 131736

- 4. The event is open to all fully paid-up members of the organising club and any club which is a member of the Scottish Association of Motorsport Clubs.
- The Clubman Autotest is a round of the following championships: The 2023 RALLYSCORE SAMSC Scottish Autotest Championship The North East of Scotland Motorsports Club Championship

The Stonehaven & District Motor Club Championship

6. All competitors must hold a valid club membership card and a current RS Clubman licence. Motorsport UK licences cannot be applied for on the day.

Signing on will be completed at the event.

The Closing date for entries will be 20:00 Wednesday 7th June 2023

7. The programme of the meeting shall be:-

Paddock Opens 09.30hrs - All competitors must be at the venue by 10:00 at the latest.

First Car Starts 10.30hrs SHARP!!!

8. The Clubman Autotest will consist of 5 classes as follows:-

Class A Specials & Kit Cars

Class B All other vehicles up to 1400cc Class C All other vehicles 1401 and over

Class D Cars to SDMC "Fiesta Class" regulations

Class E Hybrid or Electric Powered Cars – Must be Standard Production Cars

The Clubman Production Car Autotest will consist of 1 class as follows:-

Class F Production cars all capacities (as per M19)

In the Production Car Autotest a passenger must be carried at all times.(M16) Passengers must be a member of one of the invited clubs and must be signed on.

The passenger must be aged 12 years or over at least 135cm in height and wear a seat belt.

Where the driver does not hold a full RTA licence the passenger must hold one and be experienced in Autotests or Autosolos.

Competitors in a cabriolet or sports car may compete without the hood erected or hardtop fitted, but please note M16.5 regarding passengers.

Entries will be accepted from drivers aged 14 years or over in accordance with M17.

Where the competitor is under 18 the entry form must be countersigned by a parent or guardian. The parent or guardian or an appointed representative must be present during the competition and must sign on the competitors' signing on section in the app. If a parent or guardian will not be present, a responsible adult must be appointed, and must show written authority from the parent or guardian to act as the child's representative on a Motorsport UK Parental Consent Form and must countersign the competitors' signing on sheet.

- 9. All vehicles must comply with Motorsport UK Technical Regulations.
- 10. The event will take place wholly on private property and vehicles do not require to be road taxed.
- 11. Any vehicle may be used by more than one competitor but by a maximum of two.
- 12. No Individual class awards will be presented at the event. Awards may be presented at the annual SDMC Dinner & Awards night.
- 13. The entry list opens when posted on the SDMC Facebook page. The entry fee is £25.00. All entries should be made via this link. Entry Form Payment should be made by BACS Payment to the SDMC Club account using the drivers name as reference.

The maximum entry for the meeting is 20 and the minimum is 10. The minimum for each class is 4. Should either of the above minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary..

- 17. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event.
- 18. Any protests must be lodged as per C5.
- 19. There will be five tests. Each driver will have three runs at each test with the best two runs to count.
- 20. Timing will be by Timing App Live
- 21. The starting signal will be 3, 2, 1, Go.
- 22. The order of attempting tests will be at the event organiser's discretion.
- 23. Practising will not be allowed.
- 24. Marking and penalties will be as printed in Table M7 of the Motorsport UK General Regulations.
- 25. Course markers may be less than 1m in height.
- 26. Competitors must attempt all tests in the same vehicle to be classified as a finisher.
- 27. Anyone practising or travelling at excessive speed out with the specified course will be automatically excluded.
- 28. Access to the venue is by permission of the landowner, please obey all speed limit signs and be considerate to local residents who have had PR contact prior to the event date. We depend on this venue, please do not give the landowner any reason to withdraw his permission.
- 29. Final instructions will be emailed to all entrants on Thursday 8th June 2023
- 30. Data Protection Act Prospective entrants and competitors are advised that information supplied on the entry form will be held on a computer and used for the administration of the event.
