



# Stonehaven & District Motor Club Limited. 2019 Club Championship Regulations.

## 1.0 Eligibility

- 1.The Club Championship is open to all fully paid up members of Stonehaven & District Motor Club (SDMC) Limited.
2. Points will only be awarded to fully paid up members of Stonehaven & District Motor Club (SDMC) Limited.
- 3.Club members who wish to win either the Overall Club Championship or the Ladies Championship **MUST** officiate or marshal on at least 1 event organised by SDMC or marshal on an event that SDMC have been asked to assist with during the current calendar year.
- 4.The Junior Championship is open to all SDMC members aged 21 years or under at 31<sup>st</sup> December of the current calendar year.
- 5.The Senior Championship is open to all SDMC members aged 50 years or over at 1<sup>st</sup> January of the current calendar year.
- 6.The Marshal's Championship is open to all individuals who marshal on SDMC organised events or events at which SDMC have been requested to marshal irrespective of whether they are club members or not. See Club Championship table for eligible events. Marshalling events may be added during the year : volunteer requests will be posted in the e-Romer.

## 2.0 Entries for Events

Event regulations and entry forms will be available on the SDMC website (www.sdmc.co.uk) or from the event organiser as early as possible prior to each event.

## 3.0 Number of Events to Count

The number of events that count towards a competitor's final score in each championship is defined by this table :

For example, if **7** events run in a championship, only the top **5** scores will count (as above). If more than 22 events count one extra score will count for each two events added. In the Marshal's Championship ALL events count.

## 4.0 Points System

A straight 10, 9, 8,.... points system will be used. In all disciplines points will be awarded based on class positions. . i.e. the first SDMC finisher in any given class scores 10 points, the second 9 etc. If the event is organised by SDMC, competitors must enter under SDMC to score points. For non-SDMC events points will be awarded irrespective of club entered under. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that they are entered under the correct club & class on the entry list. Dual permit Navigational Rallies will amalgamate equivalent classes for overall event results & points. Junior 1000 Ecosse events will score as a class in the venue main event. Non-finishers will score one starting point. Event officials ( C of C & Sec ) will score 10 points in the Overall Championship once only for organising an event. Individuals who marshal on eligible events will score three Marshal's Championship points.

## 5.0 Best Performance only to count

Where a competitor enters more than once in any event, then only their best performance in that event shall count for points. Their other entries shall still be included in the results and calculation of other competitors' points.

## 6.0 Ties in Events

In the event of a tie for a place on an event, each competitor shall receive the points for that place. Event tie-breakers will not be used.

## 7.0 Ties in Championship

In the event of a tie in any section for an award, the award shall be given to the competitor gaining the greater number of first placings, then the number of second and subsequent placings shall be considered. To be eligible for any championship competitors must obtain 2 or more scores in that championship. Any disputes or deadlocks will be resolved at the committee's discretion.

Should a championship counter be postponed or cancelled its re-run date or substitute event will be communicated via the website, Facebook page & e-mail. Similarly additional events may be added if deemed suitable. The Championship will run from January to December. Individual event dates can be found on the Championship table & NESMC calendar ( see links below ).

**1. Club Championship** - All schedule events ( item 8.0 ) are eligible, subject to item 3.0. Marshalling / organising credit required.

**2. Ladies Championship** - All schedule events ( item 8.0 ) are eligible, subject to item 3.0. Marshalling / organising credit required.

**3. Rally Championship** - (events to count as per item 3.0) - Consists of Expert, Non-Expert, and Novice classes. If an event is run under a dual permit the results from both will be combined to calculate class points in the Rally Championship. Stage, Classic & Junior 1000 Ecosse events will be awarded appropriate navigational class points based on overall event classification. Competitors will be deemed Experts until they validly compete in a SDMC Championship counter navigational event in a different class. Stage, single venue, navigational & classic rallies count towards the Rally Championship.

**4. Autotest Championship** - (events to count as per item 3.0)

Sealed & loose surface autotest & PCA events count towards the Autotest Championship.

**5. Speed Championship** - (events to count as per item 3.0)

Autocross, loose surface PCA, hill climb, sprint & rally time trial ( gravel sprint ) events count towards the Speed Championship. Autocross events run by any NESMC member club may be added to the Championship and will be notified via the website, Facebook page & e-mail. All Fintray & Boyndie double-header weekends are included in the Speed Championship ( 8 possible scores ) . A competitor's best score from each weekend will be included in the Overall Championship (4 possible scores ).

**6. Fiesta Trophy** - (events to count as per item 3.0) For competitors in Fiesta Trophy eligible cars. See website for formula regs. PCT, autotest, PCA, autocross, clubcross, sprint & hill climb events count towards the Fiesta Trophy

**7. Junior Championship** – is awarded to the highest placed Junior in the Club Championship at year-end.

**8. Senior Championship** – is awarded to the highest placed Senior in the Club Championship at year-end.

**9. Marshal's Championship** - All eligible scores count : see items 1.3 & 1.6 of these regulations.
